

Painting the Butterfly

Basecoat outside edges with Burnt Umber and blue sections with Laguna. Shade blue sections with Ocean Blue. Blend wet on wet with the Laguna. Highlight with Titanium White blended with Laguna. Paint top border with Lamp Black. Paint the head and the antennae with Lamp Black. Shade the body with Black. Highlight with dry brush of Bahama Blue first and then with Bahama Blue plus Titanium White. Shade

with Sapphire. Shade the brown sections with Lamp Black. Highlight the Burnt Umber sections with a drybrush using Burnt Umber + Titanium White. Also fill in the small bottom sections with this mix. Add White dots and lines on the outside edge. Add lighter dots of Burnt Umber + Titanium White. Highlight the body with Burnt Umber + Titanium White. Highlight with Titanium White. Shade with Ultramarine Blue. Add some Coral Shell tints. Add tints of Coral Shell + Scarlet. Shade those sections with Burnt Umber + Scarlet. Shade with Burnt Umber + Black. Mix Lamp Black + Titanium White + Bahama Blue and float the cast shadow underneath the butterfly. Shade with Black.
